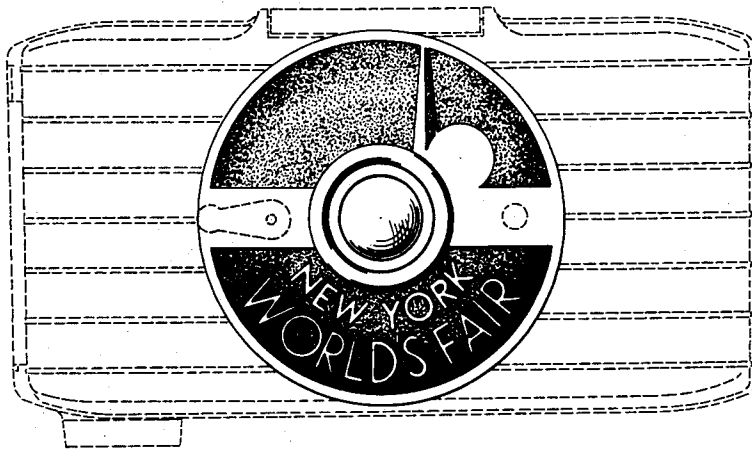

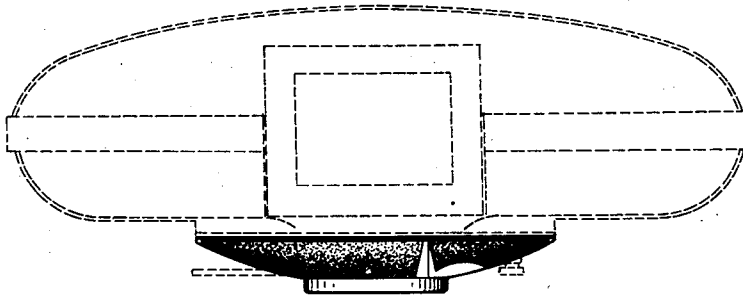
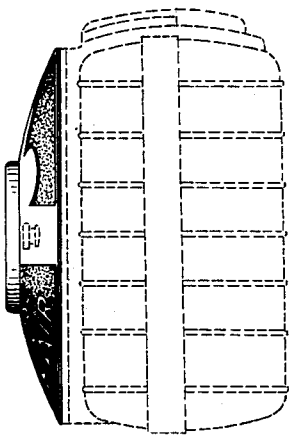

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Walter D. Teague, a citizen of the United States and residing at New York city, in the county and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Camera, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof and in which:

Fig. 1 is a front view;

Fig. 2 is a side view; and

Fig. 3 is an end view of a camera showing my new design.
